

Bywyd Gwylt Glaslyn Wildlife

A pair of Ospreys has been breeding in the Glaslyn Valley since 2004. In 2012 Bywyd Gwylt Glaslyn Wildlife, a not-for-profit Community Interest Company was formed to take over from the RSPB the running of viewing centre at Pont Croesor near Porthmadog, the protection of the breeding Ospreys and to promote opportunities for the public to experience the diverse wildlife in the Glaslyn Valley.

Good progress has been made and Bywyd Gwylt Glaslyn Wildlife now has an exciting opportunity for a Project Manager to provide leadership and innovation to a dedicated team of volunteers, and to oversee and manage the development of the Viewing Site at Pont Croesor during 2014 and early 2015. The Project Manager will also work with the Directors of BGGW to promote the project, create links with local schools, businesses, and residents, the on line community, media, visitors to the area and possible funders.

The successful candidate will have an environmental background and experience of working with volunteers and local communities. In addition they will have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, and knowledge and experience of developing novel approaches to inspiring a diverse audience about the rich natural and cultural heritage of the Glaslyn Valley. They must be able to work independently, as well as part of a team. A full driving license is required, as well as the ability to communicate in both Welsh and English.

The post holder will report to the Board of Directors of Bywyd Gwylt Glaslyn Wildlife.
